This survey training course is a two-day basic overview of immigration law with a focus on family-based immigration. Topics covered include immigrating through marriage and other family relationships; the application process for permanent residence; grounds of inadmissibility; affidavits of support; remedies under the Violence Against Women Act; removal proceedings; citizenship; and BIA recognition and accreditation. Recent changes to the law will be included. The training will be presented by CLINIC attorney Charles Wheeler and local Houston attorneys.

The training is for the staff of Catholic Charities and other community-based organizations with IRS 501(c)(3) status, and attorneys and legal worker staff of private law offices. The training is intended for legal workers and lawyers new to immigration law practice, and for more experienced advocates in need of review or updates.
