Participants will receive CLINIC's Bars and Waivers manual. The training will be presented by Charles Wheeler, Director, Division of Training and Technical Support, CLINIC and Adam Chester, Attorney at Law, Las Vegas, Nevada

The training is for the staff of Catholic Charities and other community-based organizations with IRS 501(c)(3) status, and attorneys and legal worker staff of private law offices.
