ORDER

Before: THOMAS, Chief Judge, HURWITZ and BADE, Circuit Judges.

Petitioner's unopposed motion to vacate the Board of Immigration Appeals' ("BIA") order (Docket Entry No. 19) is granted.

The government's motion to remand this case to the BIA (Docket Entry No. 16) is granted.

The decision of the BIA currently under review (*Matter of E-R-A-L-*, 27 I. & N. Dec. 767 (BIA 2020)) is vacated, and the matter is remanded to the BIA for further proceedings consistent with the government's motion to remand. On remand, the BIA shall permit the parties to submit further briefing and shall address the issues raised in any brief submitted by Petitioner, as well as the issues raised in his motion to reopen, filed May 8, 2020.

Petitioner's removal will remain stayed until further order of the Court.

The parties shall bear their own costs and fees.
