Noem issuing a partial vacatur of the July 2024 decision previously issued by the Biden administration to extend TPS for Haiti until Feb. 3, 2026.</p> <p>However, also on July 1, 2025, a <a href="#">federal judge made a ruling</a> that reinstated the February 2026 termination date.
