Haiti	On July 1, 2025, USCIS published a notice in the Federal Register announcing the termination of the designation of Haiti for TPS. The designation was set to expire on Aug. 3, 2025, a result of Sec. Noem issuing a partial vacatur of the July 2024 decision previously issued by the Biden administration to extend TPS for Haiti until Feb. 3, 2026.  However, also on July 1, 2025, a federal judge made a ruling that reinstated the February 2026 termination date. The government will likely appeal this decision.
