On May 23, 2017, I appeared before ICE for my check-in and was detained.
- 7. I have not been charged or convicted of any criminal offenses since 2015.
- 8. I am afraid to return back to back to because it is dangerous in my country and I have a specific fear. I fear for my safety from retaliation by gangs because I stepped in to stop them from beating a friend who was being attacked on the street. After the incident, the gangs threatened to kill me for having stopped them for beating their target, my friend. The threats were continuous and as the gang members increased their presence and threats against me, I became even more fearful.
- 9. I have submitted tax forms for the past two years. I do not believe I owe any taxes for these last two years, but if necessary, I will initiate a payment plan to ensure I have fulfilled all my obligations with the tax department.
- 10. From 2003 through 2011, I played soccer for a league in Leesburg, VA. I played for two and team . We played against leagues from other counties. In teams, team approximately 2011, I had to quit playing because of a ligament injury.
