1.	Your U visa will last for <i>four</i> years. In your case, your U visa expires on, 20 Once you have reached your <i>third</i> anniversary of U status (in your case, on, 20), you will be eligible to apply for Lawful Permanent Residence in the United States (green card). You must apply for your Lawful Permanent Residence between your third anniversary and the time your U visa expires. If you take no action and your U visa expires, you will be ineligible to apply for Lawful Permanent Residence and will lose your U visa status [client initials]
2.	Neither our office nor the U.S. Department of Homeland Security will remind you to apply for your Lawful Permanent Residence between your third and fourth U visa anniversaries. It is your responsibility to remember to apply on time. Please contact our office or another immigration legal services organization or attorney at or immediately prior to your third U visa anniversary (on, 20) to obtain assistance in applying for Lawful Permanent Residence (green card) [client initials]
3.	At the time that you apply for your Lawful Permanent Residence, you will need to submit documentation showing that you have resided continuously in the United States for the period of the U visa. Therefore, it is very important that you maintain documents to show your physical presence for every month between now and when you apply for your Permanent Residence. Documents demonstrating physical presence can include, for example: tax records, pay stubs, bank accounts, bills, leases, medical records, school records, etc[client initials]
4.	If you are asked to do so, it is very important that you continue to cooperate with the investigation of the crime of which you were a victim. In order to be eligible for permanent resident status you will have to prove that you never unreasonably refused to give information to the police about the crime. [client initials]
5.	With very limited exceptions, you may not travel outside of the United States with your U visa. If an emergency absolutely requires you to travel abroad, please contact our office or another immigration legal services organization or attorney as soon as possible (do not leave the U.S. before consulting with our office or another attorney)[client initials]

In your case, you must do the following in order to ensure continued status for your derivatives [caseworker to fill in additional future actions, with deadlines – ex., must do I-539 to extend U for aged-out derivative, additional consular processing
