

Positive and Negative Public Charge Factors

This chart summarizes the positive and negative factors that USCIS and DOS will consider in assessing whether an individual is inadmissible as likely to become a public charge. Heavily weighted factors are in bold. The USCIS factors can be found in Volume 8, Part G of the USCIS Policy Manual. The DOS factors can be found in the Foreign Affairs Manual at 9 FAM 302.8.
